What we did in September

- Ground surveys were completed
- Some site investigations were started
- A topographical survey was completed
- We began work on looking at potential alignments for the link – using comments from public consultation.

We attended the St. Peter's Residents Association and the Pottery Bank Residents Association and displayed the scheme, answered questions and took comments.

Following this preliminary consultation, a letter will be sent to all households in the area surrounding the site advertising two drop-in sessions.

Comments will be used to create a draft detailed design which will be presented at Byker's ward committee meeting on 17th November 2009 and Walker's ward committee meeting on 18th November 2009.

We will hold a drop-in session before the meeting and will answer any questions residents may have and we will be on hand to take comments.

The draft detailed design will then be displayed at the Ouseburn Regeneration Centre, Walker Library, Walker Riverside Information Centre and online, as well as at drop-in sessions to be confirmed in December 2009.

Further public consultation will be carried out and first draft of a detailed design will be drawn up.
